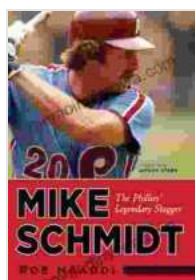

Early Life and Career

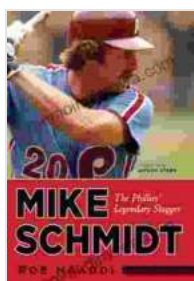
