

### How to conduct a SEMI analysis


When looking at the work of other artists it is useful to use the acronym SEMI to ensure that you demonstrate you have a good understanding of the artist's work.

**Subject:** What is being shown in the image?

**Elements:** Talk about the Formal elements, line, tone, colour, form, texture, and composition, pattern and shape.

**Materials:** What materials has the artist used?

**Intent:** What is the artist trying to communicate through this piece of work? Include a quote.

The above photographs of Karl Blossfeldt, after enlarging all details could use a grid enlargement to produce a Karl Blossfeldt study from one of his images.

Art teacher: Take your own photographs in the style of Karl Blossfeldt and work from these to make your own drawings using different mark making techniques.

**Subject:** This black and white photograph depicts a bunch of star-shaped leaves.

**Elements:** Close up image in black and white with a high contrast that emphasize the geometric shapes which are formed by the tiny, twisted leaves.

**Composition:** The focus of this image lies on the leaves. My eye is drawn to follow the radiating forms which add interest to this image.

**Tone:** the image has high local contrast and a dark background provides a dramatic effect against the dark, spiky form.

**Materials:** Karl Blossfeldt used photocopied black and white photographs from 1900's with a 400-micro enlargement, creating a magnified detail of the plants he studied.

**Intent:** I feel that through his photographs, Blossfeldt wanted to show the intricate form, strength and engineering of plants. Rather than showing plants as being delicate with illustrations of love and femininity, Blossfeldt depicts the plants' matter as strong, round forms as if made from metal or played from stone.



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
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
